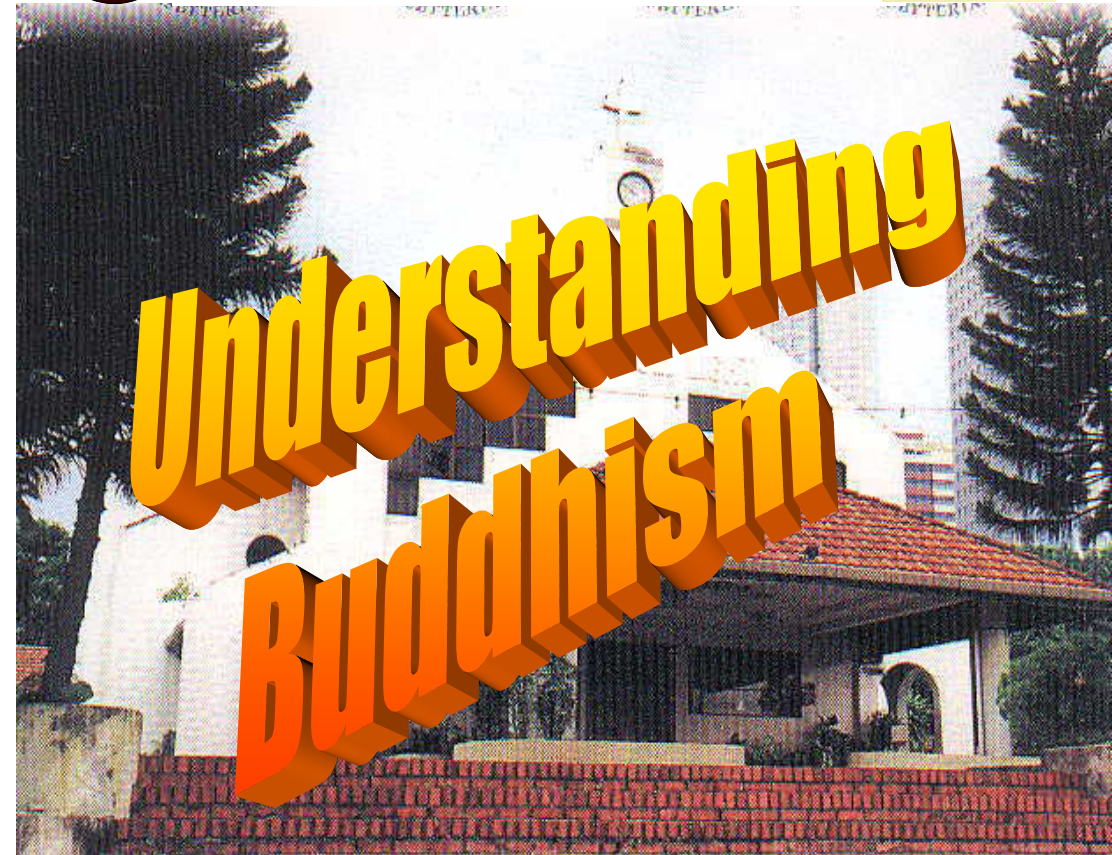

## Synopsis

Today, one billion people live under the shadow of Buddha.
